Patient Journey

We know that undertaking fertility treatment can be challenging and part of that is understanding the potential costs involved. We try hard to ensure our fees are as transparent and simple to understand as possible. We have a dedicated billing team who are there to answer any queries you have before and during your treatment.

Before you start your treatment, you should receive a clear costed treatment plan so you begin your journey knowing what your treatment should cost

Although no two journeys are the same, to make matters easier we have mapped out a patient journey and mapped out costs involved at each stage in some of our most common treatment cycles and full details are available in this price list.

Stage 1: Initial assessment

- All individuals / couples will need initial investigations to help ascertain and understand the cause of any potential issues and help to decide on and plan treatment.
- Once an initial history is taken, other tests may on occasion be recommended or required to complete an assessment.

- All but the required virology screening may also be performed at the GP and eh full list of these can be found in the detailed price list
- These are required before a first cycle and **do not** need repeating before each cycle but at specific intervals as guided by the clinical team.

Treatment Packages

We offer limited treatment packages internally for specific patient groups freezing embryos or having natural cycle treatment as below.

If a cycle is abandoned prior to egg collection, this will be disregarded from the 3 cycle package and charged at the standard abandoned cycle rate (depending on the number of scans performed). The packages are considered to be fulfilled when all 3 egg collections have been performed. All 3 cycles are to be completed within 1 year of purchase

For general IVF treatment packages we work with our partners at Access Fertility (<https://www.accessfertility.com>) and Assured Fertility (<https://assuredfertility.co.uk>) who offer multi-cycle and refund packages to Lister patients.

Duo-Stim

Duo-stim allows the collection of 2 batches of eggs with freezing in one menstrual cycle and is suitable for those requiring treatment with maximal collections in a limited time (pre cancer treatment) and those with a low ovarian reserve on a case by case basis.

Our ethos is to give every couple the best possible chance of success regardless of how that may affect our success rates. If we think you have the ability to produce more than one egg if stimulated appropriately, then we will be likely to recommend against natural IVF. However, in a small proportion it may be appropriate as stimulation is proving ineffective and want to limit unnecessary cost and intervention as guided by your clinician. These packages can be to batch embryos and thaw / transfer following all 3 cycles or can proceed with transfer in each attempt as guided by your clinician.

This is based on a typical 12 day duration of stimulation (but this may vary as may the dose through the cycle), standard ovitrelle trigger and use of cylogest alone to pregnancy test day.

A further cost of medications per cycle will be required for those continued beyond pregnancy test until 12 weeks which is typically cyclogest alone (but this may vary) at total cost of £202.16 for those 8 weeks

Additional note:

You will be provided with a standardised prescription at the start of your cycle, for all the medications required for your IVF protocol. During your cycle you may need to purchase extra medications, depending on your response and there may be occasion where medications need to be changed.

There may also be scenarios where not all medications purchased are used and so it is important to be aware, that medications dispensed from pharmacy are not returnable and once purchased, a refund is not possible.
